

PRIVACY AND COOKIE STATEMENT

The activities of Stratum Resin Flooring Limited consists of the supply and application of synthetic floor systems. To perform our activities as best as possible, it is sometimes necessary to process your personal data. Personal data are data that provide information about an individual, such as contact details, but also financial data or other privacy-sensitive information.

We only collect personal data when we perform a contract for you, or when you visit one of our premises or our website. We mainly use personal data in order to perform the contract for you. Personal data includes data that relates to your employees or customers, for example.

When we process personal data, we always do this carefully and in accordance with the law, and our internal privacy policy. The basic principles of our internal privacy policy are as follows:

We always tell you what we do with your data on how you can exercise your rights, such as your right of access and right to object.

We only use data for the purpose for which they have been collected (such as performing a contract, contract management, customer accounting, and marketing).

We do not collect, use and retain more data than we need to achieve the purpose for which we have obtained the data and we only collect, use and retain data if we cannot achieve this purpose through other means.

The more privacy-sensitive data are, the less use we make of such data.

We only use data to the extent that the law provides a legal basis for doing so.

We take suitable security measures against the loss of, or unauthorised access to, personal data.

We only disclose your personal data to third parties if we are provided with sufficient guarantees for the protection of your data.

This Privacy Statement provides information about what we do with the personal data we obtain in the performance of activities. In this Privacy Statement we answer the following questions:

FOR CUSTOMERS AND BUSINESS RELATIONS

Which data do we process?

- Contact details of the customer or their legal representatives (such as their first name, last name, address and telephone number);
- Data that will be necessary to perform the project (such as data about the end user and their employees or customers);
- Data that will be necessary to calculate or record invoices, make payments and collect receivables.

Why do we process your data?

- Providing services and advice to customers;
- Purchasing services and products from our suppliers;
- For account management, marketing, customer accounting and service purposes; in order to:
- Share with you the latest news about Stratum;
- Inform you about relevant products and services;
- Facilitate sales promotion activities;
- Measure the response to our marketing campaigns;
- Enable customer accounting and accounts receivable management;
- Manage a Customer Management System (CMS); and
- Conduct market research.

Why are we allowed to use your personal data?

- The use of your personal data is necessary in order to:
- Perform our contract;
- Comply with our statutory obligation;
- Exercise our legitimate interest in being able to (continue to) offer our services and products to our customers as efficiently as possible; and
- Represent your legitimate interest in receiving the best possible products and services in accordance with Stratum's standards.

Who has access to your data?

- Stratum uses various systems for the processing of your personal data, and your personal data may therefore also be accessed by the providers of those systems.
- Only Stratum employees who need the personal data in order to perform their work have direct access to your data in Stratum's systems.
- Stratum sometimes shares personal data with market research firms and other third parties. Where possible, we do this in an anonymized form.

How long to we retain your personal data?

- We remove the data once we no longer it for the intended purpose, except if we must maintain it for a longer period pursuant to a statutory provision, or if retaining it for longer is truly necessary for the performance of our activities.

Do I need to provide this data to Stratum?

- The processing of this personal data is necessary if you use our services, as we cannot deliver our products and/or provide our services properly without this data.

FOR VISITORS OF THE WEBSITE

(If you complete the contact form for example)

Which data do we process?

- Contact details (such as name and email address);
- The message you have left with us, including any personal data in your message;
- Cookies (explained below)

Why do we process your data?

- For service purposes: to be able to follow up your message and inform you about the follow-up steps.
- For account management, marketing, customer accounting and service purposes (to share with you the latest news about Stratum and inform you about relevant products and services); for marketing and to measure the response to our marketing campaigns, and to improve the management of our Customer Management System (CMS) and the functioning of our website).

Why are we allowed to use your personal data?

- In order to exercise our legitimate interest in being able to (continue to) offer our services and products to the visitors of our website as efficiently as possible and to use our website as best as possible.

Who has access to your personal data?

- Stratum uses various systems for the processing of your personal data, and your personal data may also therefore be processed by the providers of those systems.
- Only Stratum employees who need the personal data in order to perform their work have direct access to your data in Stratum's systems.

How long do we retain your personal data?

We remove the data once we no longer need it for the intended purpose, except if we must maintain it for a longer period pursuant to a statutory provision, or if retaining it for longer is truly necessary for the performance of our activities.

Do I need to provide this data to Stratum?

The processing of this personal data is necessary if you use our services, as we cannot deliver our products and/or provide our services properly without this data.

FOR VISITORS TO STRATUM PREMISES

Why do we process your data?

For internal control and business security purposes.

Why are we allowed to use your personal data?

The use of your personal data is necessary in order to exercise the legitimate interest of Stratum or its third parties. That legitimate interest is the interest of Stratum in securing its properties.

Who has access to your data?

- Stratum uses various systems for the processing of your personal data, and your personal data may also therefore be processed by the providers of those systems.
- Only Stratum employees who need the personal data in order to perform their work have direct access to your data in Stratum's systems.

How long do we retain your personal data?

We retain your contact details for no longer than 6 months after you visited our building, except if we must maintain it for a longer period pursuant to a statutory provision, or if retaining it for longer is truly necessary for the performance of our activities.

Do I need to provide this data to Stratum?

The processing of this personal data is necessary if you want to access Stratum premises.

Clicking behavior and visitor data

The website collects general visitor data. This may specifically involve the registration of your computer's IP address, your username, if any, the time of retrieval and data sent by your browser, which may be used for statistical analysis of the visitor and clicking behavior on our website. This enables us, amongst other things, to optimize the functioning of the website. Where possible, Stratum anonymizes any data it discloses. The data is not disclosed to third parties.

Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics to monitor how users use our website, and to monitor the effectiveness of our AdWords adverts that appear next to Google search results. The information thus obtained, including your computer's IP address, is transferred to and stored on servers in the United States by Google. Google uses this information to monitor how our website is used, to report to us about our website, and to provide its advertisers with information about the effectiveness of their campaigns. Google may disclose this information to third parties if Google is required to do so by law, or if these third parties process the information on Google's behalf. We cannot influence this.

Social Media

Social media platforms include buttons to promote or share pages in social networks. These buttons rely on a code that is supplied by the platform itself. This code places a cookie and other data. For more information on what social media platforms do with your personal data and how they process this code, please check for social media platform's privacy statements (which may change regularly).

Use of cookies

In offering our electronic services we use cookies. A cookie is a simple small file that is sent along with pages of this website and stored by your browser on your computer's hard disk. We use cookies to remember your settings and preferences. You can disable these cookies via your browser. For instructions on how you can change your cookie settings, please contact your browser provider.

The American company Google places cookies via our website as part of its Analytics service. We use this service to monitor how users use our website and to receive reports about this. Google may disclose this information to third parties if Google is required to do so by law, or if these third parties process the information on Google's behalf. We cannot influence this.

What about the use of my data by third parties?

- Stratum has made agreements with all parties to which it discloses personal data, which ensures there are sufficient guarantees for the careful processing of your personal data in accordance with the law and Stratum's internal privacy policy.
- Third parties are only granted access to your personal data if that is in accordance with the purposes for which the data has been obtained and in accordance with the relevant statement. The applicable confidentiality and security required by law are complied with, in order to prevent that your data are disclosed to third parties without good reason.
- If we must disclose your data to competent authorities based on a statutory requirement, Stratum will always look for options to protect your privacy as much as possible.
- In principle, your personal data will not be sent to locations outside of Europe, except if the purpose for which the data have been collected requires Stratum to do so. In that case, Stratum will only send these data to locations outside of Europe under specific statutory conditions.

How do we protect your data?

- Stratum takes all reasonable, suitable security measures to protect our visitors and participants against unlawful access or

changes to, or disclose or destruction of, their personal data. Stratum therefore complies with all the applicable statutory requirements with regard to security measures.

- In spite of all the security measures, if an incident occurs that could potentially have consequences for your data, Stratum will inform you immediately about this. We will also inform you about the measures and steps Stratum will take to prevent such incidents in future.

What are your rights?

- You can object to the use of your personal data, for example if you are of the opinion that the use of your data is not necessary for the performance of Stratum's activities or to comply with a statutory obligation.
- You can have your data rectified if you are of the opinion that the data which Stratum have recorded are inaccurate. This means you can ask Stratum which data we have about you, so that you can check them. You can then also request Stratum to limit the data we keep about you. You can ask Stratum to limit the use of your data during the period which Stratum needs to assess your request.
- You can ask Stratum to remove your data from our/the systems.
- You can ask Stratum to send/transfer the data to a third party.
- Stratum will handle and meet your request, except if Stratum has a legitimate interest pursuant to a statutory provision or another compelling legitimate interest that overrides your privacy interest. Due to technical reasons, we cannot remove all data we have stored about you in (old) backups. If your request requires Stratum to take unreasonably burdensome technical measures, Stratum is entitled to refuse your request.
